

Executive Board KSCA Eligibility Policies

As of 7/17 we only run three events, the Kansas Grade Championship, the Kansas Girls State Championship, and Kansas State Championship (March). The eligibility rules are in effect during the chess season and are enforced at the Kansas Grade Championship, the Kansas Girls State Championship, and Kansas State Championship. These rules only apply in the state of Kansas.

- 1) Eligibility for High School students
 - A bona fide student (includes foreign exchange) at a high school
 - Currently enrolled in five or more subjects
 - Eight semesters of eligibility
- 2) Eligibility requirements for all students
 - Maintain Amateur eligibility. Students must not be eligible to win money in any chess tournament in Kansas on the same day as a KSCA tournament is scheduled.
 - Students must play for the schools of attendance. The Executive Director shall make decisions regarding issues with schools of attendance.
- 3) If students become ineligible, they may apply for a hardship exemption through the Executive Director of the KSCA.
