

Welcome all Coaches and Parents to the
2018 Kansas State Scholastic Chess Championships!
March 10, 2018 at The University of Kansas

General Information:

This tournament will be a six-round Swiss-system event, open to all players who are residents of Kansas or who attend school in Kansas, and have qualified under KSCA regulations. Time control will be game-in-30 minutes, with a five second delay prior to each move. Note there will also be a blitz championship, held on Friday, March 9th in the McClendon Atrium of the LEEP2 building on the KU campus. Please refer to the separate flyer for that event.

Check-In:

Coaches (including parents serving as coaches, one coach per team) may check-in their teams from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM. Please download two copies of your team rosters, one to sign and submit at registration with payment, and one to keep for yourself on March 10. Make any corrections on the team sheet, but note you may not change sections for players unless the error was made by KSCA.

Please arrive early. Registration will be closed at 9:00 AM

No players in the registration area. There will a table to collect information for USCF, as all games in the K-3 and K-12 sections will be USCF rated. If forms are not filled out. Only the Coach/Adult responsible for each school team will be permitted to pay and check in. Please have items ready when checking in.

General Rules:

Players must be supervised by an adult. Any player without adult supervision will be removed from the tournament. K-12 & K-8, and K-5 & K-3 players will be instructed to write the round time for the next round on front page of score booklet. There is no lunch break, so please eat between rounds. The Kansas Union provides lunch on the 3rd floor. No outside catering is permitted. Parents are asked to help keep players supervised. Unruly conduct from players will not be tolerated, and may lead to removal from the tournament.

The K-12 and K-3 section will be USCF rated. See flyer for online form or paper form. These must be completed at registration if you are new or renewing. The \$20 registration fee for K-12 includes a one-year USCF membership fee.
